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A true prophet prays for people and that person lives:

“And now, return the man’s wife, for he is a prophet, and let him pray for you and you live. But if you do not return her, know that you shall certainly die, you and all that are yours.” Genesis 20:7

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Remember:

“And Mosheh (Moses) said to the people, “Remember this day in which you went out of Mitsrayim (Egypt), out of the house of slavery. For by strength of hand יהוה (Yehovah) brought you out of this place, and whatever is leavened shall not be eaten.” Exodus 13:3

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Healing:

“And He said, “If you diligently obey the voice of יהוה (Yehovah) your Elohim (God) and do what is right in His eyes, and shall listen to His commands and shall guard all His laws, I shall bring on you none of the diseases I brought on the Mitsrayim (Egypt - Egyptians), for I am יהוה (Yehovah) who heals you.” Exodus 15:26

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Remember:

“Remember the Sabbath day, to set it apart.” Exodus 20:8

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Healing:

“And you shall serve יהוה (Yehovah) your Elohim (God), and He shall bless your bread and your water. And I shall remove sickness from your midst.” Exodus 23:25

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Remember:

“And it shall be to you for a tzitzit (fringes), and you shall see it, and shall remember all the commands of יהוה (Yehovah) and shall do them, and not search after your own heart and your own eyes after which you went whoring,” Numbers 15:39

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Remember:

“And you shall remember that you were a slave in the land of Mitsrayim (Egypt), and that יהוה (Yehovah) your Elohim (God) brought you out from there by a strong hand and by an outstretched arm. Therefore יהוה (Yehovah) your Elohim (God) commanded you to perform the Sabbath day.” Deuteronomy 5:15

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Remember:

“When you say in your heart, ‘These nations are greater than I, I am unable to drive them out,’ ” do not be afraid of them. Remember well what יהוה (Yehovah) your Elohim (God) did to Pharaoh and to all Mitsrayim (Egypt),” Deuteronomy 7:18

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Remember:

“And you shall remember that יהוה (Yehovah) your Elohim (God) led you all the way these forty years in the wilderness, to humble you, prove you, to know what is in your heart, whether you guard His commands or not.” Deuteronomy 8:2

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Remember:

“But you shall remember יהוה (Yehovah) your Elohim (God), for it is He who gives you power to get wealth, in order to establish His covenant which He swore to your fathers, as it is today.” Deuteronomy 8:18

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Remember:

“Remember, do not forget how you provoked to wrath יהוה (Yehovah) your Elohim (God) in the wilderness. From the day that you came out of the land of Mitsrayim (Egypt) until you came to this place, you have been rebellious against יהוה (Yehovah).” Deuteronomy 9:7

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Remember:

“And you shall remember that you were a slave in the land of Mitsrayim (Egypt), and יהוה (Yehovah) your Elohim (God) ransomed you. Therefore I am commanding you this word today.” Deuteronomy 15:15

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Remember:

“Eat no leavened bread with it. For seven days you eat unleavened bread with it, bread of affliction, because you came out of the land of Mitsrayim (Egypt) in haste – so that you remember the day in which you came out of the land of Mitsrayim (Egypt), all the days of your life.” Deuteronomy 16:3

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Remember:

“And you shall remember that you were a slave in Mitsrayim (Egypt), and you shall guard and do these laws.” Deuteronomy 16:12

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Deuteronomy 24:

“When a man takes a wife and shall marry her, then it shall be, if she finds no favour in his eyes because he has found a matter of uncoveredness in her, and he shall write her a certificate of divorce, and put it in her hand, and send her out of his house, and if she left his house and went and became another man’s wife, and the latter husband shall hate her and write her a certificate of divorce, and put it in her hand, and send her out of his house, or when the latter husband dies who took her to be his wife, then her former husband who sent her away is not allowed to take her back to be his wife after she has been defiled, for that would be an abomination before יהוה. And do not bring sin on the land which יהוה your Elohim is giving you as an inheritance.

“When a man has taken a new wife, let him not go out into the army nor let any matter be imposed upon him. He shall be exempt one year for the sake of his home, to rejoice with his wife whom he has taken. No one takes in pledge the lower or the upper millstone, for he would be taking a life in pledge.

“When a man is found kidnapping any of his brothers or the children of Yisra’el (Israel), and treats him harshly or sells him, then that kidnapper shall die. Thus you shall purge the evil from your midst.

“Take heed, in an outbreak of leprosy, to diligently guard and do according to all that the priests, the Lēwites (Levites), teach you. As I have commanded them, so you shall guard to do.

“Remember what יהוה (Yehovah) your Elohim did to Miryam on the way when you came out of Mitsrayim (Egypt).

“When you lend your brother a loan, do not go into his house to get his pledge.

“Stand outside, and let the man to whom you lend bring the pledge out to you.

“And if the man is poor, do not sleep with his pledge.

“By all means return the pledge to him at sundown, and he shall sleep in his own garment, and shall bless you. And it shall be righteousness to you before יהוה (Yehovah) your Elohim (God).

“Do not oppress a hired servant who is poor and needy, of your brothers or of your strangers who are in your land within your gates.

“Give him his wages on the same day, and do not let the sun go down on it, for he is poor and lifts up his being to it, so that he does not cry out against you to יהוה (Yehovah), and it shall be sin in you.

“Fathers are not put to death for their children, and children are not put to death for their fathers, each is to die for his own sin.

“Do not twist the right-ruling of a stranger or the fatherless, nor take the garment of a widow.

“But you shall remember that you were a slave in Mitsrayim (Egypt), and that יהוה (Yehovah) your Elohim ransomed you from there. Therefore I am commanding you to do this word.

“When you reap your harvest in your field, and have forgotten a sheaf in the field, do not go back to get it. Let it be for the stranger, for the fatherless, and for the widow, so that יהוה (Yehovah) your Elohim (God) might bless you in all the work of your hands.

“When you beat your olive trees, do not examine the branch behind you. Let it be for the stranger, for the fatherless, and for the widow.

“When you gather the grapes of your vineyard, do not glean behind you. Let it be for the stranger, for the fatherless, and for the widow.

“And you shall remember that you were a slave in the land of Mitsrayim (Egypt). Therefore I am commanding you to do this word.” Deuteronomy 24

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Remember:

“Remember what Amalēq (Amelek) did to you on the way as you were coming out of Mitsrayim (Egypt),” Deuteronomy 25:17

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Deuteronomy 32, The Song of Moses (we are commanded to memorize, Deut 31:21):

“Give ear, O heavens, and let me speak; And hear, O earth, The words of my mouth. Let my instruction fall as rain, My speech drop down as dew, As fine rain on the tender plants, And as showers on the grass. For I proclaim the Name of יהוה (Yehovah), Ascribe greatness to our Elohim (God). The Rock! His work is perfect, For all His ways are right-ruling, An Ėl (God) of truth and without unrighteousness, Righteous and straight is He. A twisted and crooked generation has corrupted itself, Their blemish, they are not His children. Do you do this to יהוה (Yehovah), O foolish and unwise people? Is He not your Father, who bought you, Who created you and established you?

Remember the days of old, Consider the years of many generations. Ask your father and let him show you, Your elders, and let them say to you. When the Most High gave the nations their inheritance When He separated the sons of Ađam, He set the boundaries of the peoples According to the number of the children of Yisra’el (Israel). For the portion of יהוה (Yehovah) is His people, Ya’aqob (Jacob) His allotted inheritance. He found him in a wilderness, And in a wasted, howling desert. He encompassed him, He made him understand, He watched over him as the apple of His eye.

As an eagle stirs up its nest, Flutters over its young, Spreading out its wings, taking them up, Bearing them on its wings. יהוה (Yehovah) alone led him, And there was no strange mighty one (god) with him. He made him ride in the heights of the earth, And he ate the fruit of the fields, And He made him to draw honey from the rock, And oil from the flinty rock, Curds from the cattle, And milk of the flock, With fat of lambs, And rams of the breed of Bashan, And goats, with the choicest wheat; And you drank wine, the blood of the grapes. But Yeshurun grew fat and kicked; You grew fat, you grew thick, You are covered with fat; So he forsook Eloah (God) who made him, And scorned the Rock of his deliverance. They moved Him to jealousy with foreign matters, With abominations they provoked Him. They slaughtered to demons – not Eloah (God) – Mighty ones (gods) they did not know, New ones who came lately, Which your fathers did not fear. You neglected the Rock who brought you forth, And forgot the Ėl (God) who fathered you. And יהוה (Yehovah) saw, and despised, Because of the provocation of His sons and His daughters.

“And He said, ‘Let Me hide My face from them, Let Me see what their end is, For they are a perverse generation, Children in whom there is no trusting. They made Me jealous by what is not Ėl (God), They provoked Me with their worthless matters. But I make them jealous by those who are no people, I provoke them with a foolish nation. For a fire was kindled in My wrath And burns to the bottom of She’ol, And consumes the earth and its increase, And sets on fire the foundations of mountains.

“I gather evils upon them, I use up My arrows upon them – Wasted by scarcity of food, And consumed by heat and bitter destruction, And the teeth of beasts I send upon them, With the poison of serpents of the dust. The

sword bereaves from the outside, And fear from within, Both young man and maiden, Nursing child with the man of grey hairs.

I said, 'I should blow them away, I should make the remembrance of them To cease from among men, If I did not fear the enemy's taunt, Lest their adversaries misunderstand, Lest they say, "Our hand is high, And יהוה (Yehovah) has not done all this." For they are a nation lost to counsel, And there is no understanding in them. If they were wise, They would understand this, They would consider their latter end! How would one chase a thousand, And two put ten thousand to flight, Unless their Rock had sold them, And יהוה (Yehovah) had given them up? For their rock is not like our Rock – Even our enemies are judges. "Their vine is of the vine of Seđom (Sodom) And of the fields of Amorah (Gomorrah); Their grapes are grapes of gall, Their clusters are bitter. Their wine is the poison of serpents, And the fierce venom of cobras. Is it not stored up with Me, Sealed up among My treasures? Vengeance is Mine, and repayment, At the time their foot slips; For near is the day of their calamity, And the matters prepared are hastening to them.'

"For יהוה (Yehovah) rightly rules His people And has compassion on His servants, When He sees that their power is gone, And there is no one remaining, Shut up or at large. And He shall say, 'Where are their mighty ones (gods), The rock in whom they sought refuge? Who ate the fat of their slaughterings, And drank the wine of their drink offering? Let them arise and help you, Let it be a hiding-place for you! See now that I, I am He, And there is no Elohim besides Me. I put to death and I make alive. I have wounded, and I heal. And from My hand no one delivers! For I lift My hand to the heavens, And shall say: As I live forever, If I have sharpened My flashing sword, And My hand takes hold on judgment, I shall return vengeance to My enemies, And repay those who hate Me. I make My arrows drunk with blood, And My sword devours flesh, With the blood of the slain and the captives, From the long-haired enemy chiefs.' O nations, acclaim His people! For He avenges the blood of His servants, And returns vengeance to His adversaries, And shall pardon His land, His people."

Deuteronomy 32: 1-43

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Remember:

"Remember the word which Mosheh (Moses), servant of יהוה (Yehovah), commanded you, saying, 'יהוה (Yehovah) your Elohim (God) is giving you rest, and He shall give you this land.' Joshua 1:13

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"One man of you put a thousand to flight, for יהוה (Yehovah) your Elohim (God) is He who is fighting for you, as He has promised you." Joshua 23:10

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2 Samuel 22 (The Song Of Victory)

"Then Dawid (David) spoke to יהוה (Yehovah) the words of this song, on the day when יהוה (Yehovah) had delivered him from the hand of all his enemies, and from the hand of Sha'ul (Saul).

And he said, "יהוה is my rock and my stronghold and my deliverer. My Elohim is my rock, I take refuge in Him, My shield and the horn of my deliverance, My high tower and my refuge. My Saviour, You save me from violence. I call on יהוה (Yehovah), the One to be praised, And I am saved from my enemies.

"For the waves of death surrounded me, Floods of Beliya'al made me afraid, The cords of She'ol were all around me; The snares of death were before me. In my distress I called upon יהוה (Yehovah), And to my Elohim (God) I cried. And from His Hēḵal (Holy Place) He heard my voice, And my cry was in His ears.

“And the earth shook and trembled, The foundations of the heavens were troubled, Because He was wroth. Smoke went up from His nostrils, And devouring fire from His mouth; Coals were kindled by it. And He bowed the heavens and came down, And thick darkness was under His feet.

“And He rode upon a kerub, and flew, And was seen upon the wings of the wind. And He put darkness around Him as booths, Darkness of waters, thick clouds. From the brightness before Him Coals of fire were kindled. “יהוה (Yehovah) thundered from the heavens, And the Most High sent forth His voice. And He sent out arrows and scattered them, Lightning, and confused them. And the channels of the sea were seen, The foundations of the world were uncovered At the rebuke of יהוה (Yehovah), At the blast of the breath of His nostrils. He sent from above, He took me, He drew me out of many waters. He delivered me from my strong enemy, From those hating me, For they were stronger than I. They confronted me in the day of my calamity, But יהוה (Yehovah) was my support. And He brought me out into a large place, He delivered me for He delighted in me.

“יהוה (Yehovah) rewarded me according to my righteousness; According to the cleanness of my hands He repaid me. For I have guarded the ways of יהוה (Yehovah) And have not acted wrongly against my Elohim (God). For all His right-rulings are before me; As for His laws, I do not turn from them. And I am perfect before Him, And I guard myself from my crookedness.

“And יהוה (Yehovah) repays me according to my righteousness, According to my cleanness before His eyes. With the lovingly-committed ones You show Yourself lovingly-committed, With the perfect one You show Yourself perfect, With the clean You show Yourself clean, And with the crooked You show Yourself twisted. For You save the humble people, But Your eyes are on the haughty to bring them low. For You are my lamp, O יהוה (Yehovah), And יהוה (Yehovah) makes my darkness light. For with You I run against a band, With my Elohim I leap over a wall. The Ĕl (God) – His way is perfect; The Word of יהוה is proven; He is a shield to all who take refuge in Him. For who is Ĕl (God), besides יהוה (Yehovah)? And who is a rock, besides our Elohim (God)?

“Ĕl (God) is my mighty stronghold, And He makes my way perfect, Making my feet like the feet of deer, And sets me on my high places, Teaching my hands for battle, So that my arms bend a bow of bronze. And You give me the shield of Your deliverance, And Your lowliness makes me great. You enlarge my step under me, So that my feet shall not slip. I pursue my enemies and destroy them, And I do not turn back till they are destroyed. And I destroy them and crush them, So that they do not rise, And fall under my feet. And You gird me with strength for battle, You cause my adversaries to bow under me. And You make my enemies turn their backs, Those hating me, and I cut them off. They look but there is no saviour, Unto יהוה (Yehovah), but He shall not answer them. And I beat them as dust of the earth, I beat them small as dirt in the streets – I spread them out. And You deliver me from the strivings of my people, You safeguard me as the head of the nations; A people I have not known serve me. Sons of the foreigner submit to me, As soon as they hear they obey me. Sons of the foreigner fade away, And gird themselves from their strongholds.

“יהוה (Yehovah) lives! And blessed is my Rock! And exalted is my Elohim (God), The Rock of my deliverance, Ĕl (God) who avenges me, And bringing peoples down under me, And bringing me out from my enemies; You raise me up above those rising up against me; You deliver me from a man of violence. Therefore I give thanks to You, O יהוה (Yehovah), among nations, And I sing praise to Your Name. A tower of deliverance is He to His sovereign (king), And showing loving-commitment to His anointed, To Dawid (David) and his seed, forever.” 2 Samuel 22

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The Spirit Of Yehovah Is Upon Yeshua (7 Spirits of Yehovah):

And a Rod shall come forth from the stump of Yishai (Jesse – the father of king David), and a Sprout from his roots shall be fruitful. The Spirit of יהוה (Yehovah) shall rest upon Him – the Spirit of wisdom and

understanding, the Spirit of counsel and might, the Spirit of knowledge and of the fear of יהוה (Yehovah). And He shall not judge by the sight of His eyes, nor decide by the hearing of His ears. But with righteousness He shall judge the poor, and shall decide with straightness for the meek ones of the earth, and shall strike the earth with the rod of His mouth, and slay the wrong with the breath of His lips. And righteousness shall be the girdle of His loins, and trustworthiness the girdle of His waist. Isaiah 11:1-5

“and a spirit of right-ruling to him who sits in right-ruling, and strength to those who turn back the battle at the gate.” Isaiah 28:6

“And I looked and saw in the midst of the throne and of the four living creatures, and in the midst of the elders a Lamb standing, as having been slain, having seven horns and seven eyes, which are **the seven Spirits of Elohim sent out into all the earth.**” Revelation 5:6

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Restore me and make me live:

“O יהוה (Yehovah), by these do men live, and my spirit finds life in all of them. **Restore me and make me live.** “See, for peace I had what was bitter, bitter. But You have lovingly delivered my being from the pit of corruption, for You have cast all my sins behind Your back. For She’ol does not thank You, nor death praise You; those who go down to the pit do not watch for Your truth. “The living, the living – he is praising You, as I do this day. A father makes known Your truth to his children.” Isaiah 38:16-19

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You are chosen:

“But you, Yisra’el (Israel), are My servant, Ya’aqob (Jacob), whom I have chosen, the descendants of Abraham who loved Me, whom I have strengthened from the ends of the earth, and called from its farthest parts, and said to You, ‘You are My servant, I have chosen you and have not rejected you. Do not fear, for I am with you. Do not look around, for I am your Elohim (God). I shall fortify you, I shall also help you, I shall also uphold you with the right hand of My righteousness.’ See, all those who raged against you are ashamed and blush, they are as non-existent. And the men who strive with you perish. You seek them but do not find them, those who struggle with you. Those who fight you are as non-existent, as naught. For I, יהוה (Yehovah), your Elohim (God), am strengthening your right hand, saying to you, ‘Do not fear, I shall help you.’ Isaiah 41:8-12

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You can pass through waters and walk through fire:

“When you pass through the waters, I am with you; and through rivers, they do not overflow you. When you walk through fire, you are not scorched, and a flame does not burn you.” Isaiah 43:2

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Blessing upon your children (name all your children):

“But now hear, O Ya’aqob (Jacob) My servant, and Yisra’el (Israel) whom I have chosen. Thus said יהוה (Yehovah) who made you and formed you from the womb, who helps you, ‘Do not fear, O Ya’aqob (Jacob) My servant, and, whom I have chosen. For I pour water on the thirsty, and floods on the dry ground. I pour My Spirit on your seed, and My blessing on your offspring, and they shall spring up among the grass like willows by

streams of water.’ One says, ‘Yeshurun (Poetic name for Israel) I belong to יהוה (Yehovah); another calls himself by the name of Ya‘aqob (Jacob); another writes with his hand, ‘Unto יהוה (Yehovah),’ and names himself by the name of Yisra’el (Israel).” Isaiah 44:1-5

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Remember:

“Remember these matters, O Ya‘aqob (Jacob), and Yisra’el (Israel), for you are My servant! I have formed you, you are My servant, O Yisra’el (Israel), do not forget Me!” Isaiah 44:21

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Remember:

“Remember this, and show yourselves men; turn it back, you transgressors. “Remember the former events of old, for I am Ėl (God), and there is no one else – Elohim (God), and there is no one like Me, declaring the end from the beginning, and from of old that which has not yet been done, saying, ‘My counsel does stand, and all My delight I do,’ calling a bird of prey from the east, the man who executes My counsel, from a distant land. Indeed I have spoken it, I also bring it to pass. I have planned it, I also do it.” Isaiah 46:8-11

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Healing:

“Truly, He has borne our sicknesses and carried our pains. Yet we reckoned Him smitten, stricken by Elohim (God), and afflicted. But He was pierced for our transgressions, He was crushed for our crookednesses. The chastisement for our peace was upon Him, and by His stripes we are healed.” Isaiah 53:4-5

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Do not fear, you will forget shame of youth:

“Do not fear, for you shall not be put to shame, nor hurt, you shall not be humiliated. For the shame of your youth you shall forget, and not remember the reproach of your widowhood any more.” Isaiah 54:4

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No weapon formed will prosper:

“No weapon formed against you shall prosper, and every tongue which rises against you in judgment you shall prove wrong. This is the inheritance of the servants of יהוה (Yehovah), and their righteousness from Me,” declares יהוה (Yehovah).” Isaiah 54:17

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We must return to Him and His ways and speak His Word, for His Word will not return to Him void – SPEAK HIS WORD ALOUD:

“Seek יהוה (Yehovah), while He is to be found, call on Him while He is near. Let the wrong forsake his way, and the unrighteous man his thoughts. Let him return to יהוה (Yehovah) who has compassion on him, and to our Elohim (God), for He pardons much. For My thoughts are not your thoughts, neither are your ways My ways,” declares יהוה (Yehovah). For as the heavens are higher than the earth, so are My ways higher than your ways, and My thoughts than your thoughts.

For as the rain comes down, and the snow from the heavens, and do not return there, but water the earth, and make it bring forth and bud, and give seed to the sower and bread to the eater, so is My Word that goes forth

from My mouth – it does not return to Me empty, but shall do what I please, and shall certainly accomplish what I sent it for. For with joy you go out, and with peace you are brought in – the mountains and the hills break forth into singing before you, and all the trees of the field clap the hands. Instead of the thorn the cypress comes up, and instead of the nettle the myrtle comes up. And it shall be to יהוה (Yehovah) for a name, for an everlasting sign which is not cut off.” Isaiah 55:6-13

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Seek and you shall find Yehovah:

“And you shall seek Me, and shall find Me, when you search for Me with all your heart.” Jeremiah 29:13

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Healing:

“For I restore health to you and heal you of your wounds,” declares יהוה (Yehovah), ‘for they have called you an outcast saying, “This is Tsiyon (Zion), no one is seeking her.”’ Jeremiah 30:17

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Remember:

“You who have escaped the sword, go away! Do not stand still! Remember יהוה (Yehovah) from afar, and let Yerushalayim (Jerusalem) come to your heart.” Jeremiah 51:50

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Healing:

“See, I am bringing to it relief and healing. And I shall heal them and reveal to them the riches of peace and truth.” Jeremiah 33:6

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Remember:

“And those of you who escape shall remember Me among the nations where they have been taken captive, because I have been broken by their adulterous heart which has turned away from Me, and by their eyes which whored after their idols. And they shall loathe themselves for the evils which they have done in all their abominations.” Ezekiel 6:9

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Remember:

“And you shall remember your ways and be ashamed, when you receive your older and your younger sisters. And I shall give them to you for daughters, though not by your own covenant.” Ezekiel 16:61

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Remember:

“And you shall know that I am יהוה (Yehovah), so that you remember. And you shall be ashamed, and never open your mouth any more because of your shame, when I pardon you for all you have done,” declares the Master יהוה (Yehovah).” Ezekiel 16:63

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Remember:

“And there you shall remember your ways and all your deeds with which you were defiled. And you shall loathe yourselves in your own sight because of all the evils that you did.” Ezekiel 20:43

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Once forgiven don’t bring it up again:

“And you shall **remember** your evil ways and your deeds that were not good. And you shall loathe yourselves in your own eyes, for your crookednesses and your abominations. Ezekiel 36:31

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We must pray for one another in our lands:

“And I sought for a man among them who would make a wall, and stand in the breach before Me on behalf of the land, that I should not destroy it – but I did not find one! Therefore I have poured out My displeasure on them, I have consumed them with the fire of My wrath. And I have put their way on their own head,” declares the Master יהוה (Yehovah).” Ezekiel 22:30-31

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Yehovah, make us a people many and strong!

“Blow a shophar in Tsiyon (Zion), and sound an alarm in My set-apart mountain! Let all the inhabitants of the earth tremble, for the day of יהוה (Yehovah) is coming, for it is near: a day of darkness and gloom, a day of clouds and thick darkness, like the morning clouds spread over the mountains – **a people many and strong, the like of whom has never been, nor shall there ever be again after them, to the years of many generations.**” Joel 2:1-2

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Blowing of the Shofar scripture (Read before you blow your shofar):

And I said to the nobles, and to the deputy rulers, and to the rest of the people, “The work is great and large, and we are separated far from one another on the wall. In whatever place you hear the voice of the shophar, join us there. Our Elohim fights for us.” Nehemia 4:19-20

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Outpouring of the Holy Spirit promised:

“And after this it shall be that I pour out My Spirit on all flesh. And your sons and your daughters shall prophesy, your old men dream dreams, your young men see visions. And also on the male servants and on the female servants I shall pour out My Spirit in those days.” Joel 2:28-29, Acts 2:17-18

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EVERYONE who calls upon the Name of Yehovah, shall be delivered in the end of days:

“And it shall be that everyone who calls on the Name of יהוה (Yehovah) shall be delivered. For on Mount Tsiyon (Zion) and in Yerushalayim (Jerusalem) there shall be an escape as יהוה (Yehovah) has said, and among the survivors whom יהוה (Yehovah) calls.” Joel 2:32

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All belongs to Yehovah, you cannot sell what you do not own:

“The earth belongs to יהוה (Yehovah), And all that fills it – The world and those who dwell in it. For He has founded it upon the seas, And upon the waters He does establish it. Who does go up into the mountain of יהוה (Yehovah)? And who does stand in His set-apart place? He who has innocent hands and a clean heart, Who did not bring his life to naught, And did not swear deceivingly. He receives a blessing from יהוה (Yehovah), And righteousness from the Elohim (God) of his deliverance. This is the generation of those who seek Him; Ya’aqob (Jacob), who seek Your face. Selah.”

“Lift up your heads, O you gates! And be lifted up, you everlasting doors! And let the Sovereign (King) of esteem come in. Who is this Sovereign (King) of esteem? יהוה (Yehovah) strong and mighty, יהוה (Yehovah) mighty in battle. Lift up your heads, O you gates! Even lift up, you everlasting doors! And let the Sovereign (King) of esteem come in. Who is this Sovereign (King) of esteem? יהוה (Yehovah) of hosts, He is the Sovereign (King) of esteem! Selah.” Psalms 24

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Delight Yourself in Yehovah:

“And delight yourself in יהוה (Yehovah), And let Him give you the desires of your heart. Psalms 37:4

Nun I have been young, and now I am old; Yet I have not seen the righteous forsaken, Or his seed begging bread.” Psalms 37:25

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Psalms 91

“He who dwells in the secret place of the Most High, Who abides under the shadow of the Almighty, He is saying of יהוה (Yehovah), “My refuge and my stronghold, My Elohim (God), in whom I trust!” For He delivers you from the snare of a trapper, From the destructive pestilence. He covers you with His feathers, And under His wings you take refuge; His truth is a shield and armour.

You are not afraid of the dread by night, Of the arrow that flies by day,

Of the pestilence that walks in darkness, Of destruction that ravages at midday.

A thousand fall at your side, And ten thousand at your right hand; But it does not come near you.

Only with your eyes you look on, And see the reward of the wrong ones.

Because you have made יהוה (Yehovah) – My refuge, the Most High – your dwelling place, No evil befalls you, And a plague does not come near your tent; For He commands His messengers concerning you, To guard you in all your ways. They bear you up in their hands, Lest you dash your foot against a stone. You tread upon lion and cobra, Young lion and serpent you trample under foot.

“Because he cleaves to Me in love, Therefore I deliver him; I set him on high, **Because he has known My Name (Yehovah – Joel 2:32)**. When he calls on Me, I answer him; I am with him in distress; I deliver him and esteem him. With long life I satisfy him, And show him My deliverance.” Psalms 91

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Remember:

“Remember also your Creator in the days of your youth, before the evil days come, and the years draw near when you say, “I have no pleasure in them.” Ecclesiastes 12:1

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Call upon the Name of Yehovah:

“And it shall be that everyone who calls on the Name of יהוה (Yehovah) shall be delivered. For on Mount Tsiyon (Zion) and in Yerushalayim (Jerusalem) there shall be an escape as יהוה (Yehovah) has said, and among the survivors whom יהוה (Yehovah) calls.” Joel 2:32

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Spirit Of Favor and Prayers:

“And I shall pour on the house of Dawid (David) and on the inhabitants of Yerushalayim (Jerusalem) a spirit of favour (or grace) and prayers. And they shall look on Me whom they pierced, and they shall mourn for Him as one mourns for his only son. And they shall be in bitterness over Him as a bitterness over the first-born. Zechariah 12:10

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Remember:

“Let all the ends of the earth Remember and turn to יהוה (Yehovah), And all clans of the nations Bow themselves before You.” Psalms 22:27

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Remember:

“Remember this: the enemy has reproached יהוה (Yehovah), And a foolish people has despised Your Name.” Psalms 74:18

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Remember:

“Remember His wonders which He has done, His miracles, and the right-rulings of His mouth,” Psalms 105:5

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Remember:

“Remember to extol His work, of which men have sung.” Job 36:24

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Remember:

“Though it not be much, let him remember the days of his life, because Elohim (God) bears witness by the gladness of his heart.” Ecclesiastes 5:20

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Remember:

“Remember Him before the silver cord is loosed, or the golden bowl is broken, or the jar shattered at the fountain, or the wheel broken at the well,” Ecclesiastes 12:6

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Remember:

“Remember the Torah of Mosheh (Moses), My servant, which I commanded him in Horeb for all Yisra’el (Israel) – laws and right-rulings.” Malachi 4:4

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Remember:

“Remember His wonders which He has done, His signs and the right-rulings of His mouth...He is יהוה (Yehovah) our Elohim (God), His right-rulings are in all the earth. Remember His covenant forever, The Word He commanded for a thousand generations, Which He made with Abraham (Abraham), And His oath to Yitshaq (Isaac), And He established it to Ya’aqob (Jacob) (Jacob) for a law, To Yisra’el (Israel) as an everlasting covenant,” 1 Chronicles 16:12,14-17

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Clean of heart (also see Psalms 24):

“Blessed are the clean in heart, because they shall see Elohim (God).” Matthew 5:8

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Don’t worry about food, drink, or clothes – but seek FIRST Yehovah’s Kingdom and righteousness:

“Because of this I say to you, do not worry about your life, what you shall eat or drink, or about your body, what you shall put on. Is not life more than the food and the body more than the clothing?

Look at the birds of the heaven, for they neither sow nor reap nor gather into storehouses, yet your heavenly Father does feed them. Are you not worth more than they?

And which of you by worrying is able to add one cubit to his life’s span?

So why do you worry about clothing? Note well the lilies of the field, how they grow. They neither toil nor spin, and I say to you that even Shelomoh (Solomon) in all his esteem was not dressed like one of these.

But if Elohim (God) so clothes the grass of the field, which exists today, and tomorrow is thrown into the furnace, how much more you, O you of little belief?

Do not worry then, saying, ‘What shall we eat?’ or ‘What shall we drink?’ or ‘What shall we wear?’

For all these the nations seek for. And your heavenly Father knows that you need all these.

But seek first the reign of Elohim, and His righteousness, and all these shall be added to you.

Do not, then, worry about tomorrow, for tomorrow shall have its own worries. Each day has enough evil of itself.” Matthew 6:25-34

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Ask, Seek, Knock:

“Ask and it shall be given to you, seek and you shall find, knock and it shall be opened to you. For everyone who asks receives, and he who seeks finds, and to him who knocks it shall be opened. Or is there a man among you who, if his son asks for bread, shall give him a stone? Or if he asks for a fish, shall he give him a snake? If you then, being wicked, know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more shall your Father who is in the heavens give what is good to those who ask Him!” Matthew 7:7-11

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Yeshua desires mercy, not sacrifice:

“But go and learn what this means, ‘I desire compassion and not offering.’ For I did not come to call the righteous to repentance, but sinners.” Matthew 9:13 (and Matthew 12:7, Hosea 6:6)

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Yeshua healed them all:

“But יהושע (Yeshua), knowing it, withdrew from there. **And large crowds followed Him, and He healed them all,**” Matthew 12:15

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Ask and you shall receive:

“And יהושע (Yeshua) answering, said to them, “Truly, I say to you, if you have belief and do not doubt, you shall not only do what was done to the fig tree, but even if you say to this mountain, ‘Be removed and be thrown into the sea,’ it shall be done. And whatever you ask in prayer, believing, you shall receive.” Matthew 21:21-22

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Remember:

“Remember the wife of Lot. “Whoever seeks to save his life shall lose it, and whoever loses his life shall preserve it.” Luke 17:32-33

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Worship in Spirit and Truth:

“Our fathers worshipped on this mountain, but you people say that in Yerushalayim (Jerusalem) is the place where one needs to worship.” יהושע (Yeshua) said to her, “Woman, believe Me, the hour is coming when you shall neither on this mountain, nor in Yerushalayim (Jerusalem), worship the Father. You worship what you do not know. We worship what we know, because the deliverance is of the Yehudim (Judeans). But the hour is coming, and now is, when the true worshippers shall worship the Father in spirit and truth, for the Father also does seek such to worship Him. Elohim is Spirit, and those who worship Him need to worship in spirit and truth.” John 4:20-24

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How to partake of Yeshua and never hunger or thirst (Read all of John 6 when possible):

“And יהושע (Yeshua) said to them, “I am the bread of life. **He who comes to Me** shall not get hungry at all, and **he who believes in Me shall not get thirsty at all.**” John 6:35

“This is the bread which comes down out of the heaven, so that anyone might eat of it, and not die. I am the living bread which came down out of the heaven. If anyone eats of this bread, he shall live forever. And indeed, the bread that I shall give is My flesh, which I shall give for the life of the world.” John 6:50-51

“For My flesh is **truly food**, and My blood is **truly drink**.” John 6:55

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Do/Obey the Torah:

“Truly, truly, I say to you, if anyone guards My Word he shall never see death at all.” John 8:51

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Do the works of Yeshua:

“Truly, truly, I say to you, he who believes in Me, the works that I do he shall do also. And greater works than these he shall do, because I go to My Father. And whatever you ask in My Name, that I shall do, in order that the Father might be esteemed in the Son. If you ask whatever in My Name, I shall do it. If you love Me, you shall guard (do/obey) My commands. And I shall ask the Father, and He shall give you another Helper, to stay with you forever – the Spirit of the Truth, whom the world is unable to receive, because it does not see Him or know Him. But you know Him, for He stays with you and shall be in you.” John 14:12-17

“He who possesses My commands and guards (do/obey) them, it is he who loves Me. And he who loves Me shall be loved by My Father, **and I shall love him and manifest Myself to him**.” John 14:21

יהושע (Yeshua) answered him, ‘If anyone loves Me, he shall guard (do/obey) My Word. And My Father shall love him, and We shall come to him and make Our stay with him.’” John 14:23

“But the Helper, the Set-apart (Holy) Spirit, whom the Father shall send in My Name, He shall teach you all, and remind you of all that I said to you. John 14:26

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Yeshua Desires His Joy To Be Complete In You:

“If you stay in Me, and My Words stay in you, you shall ask whatever you wish, and it shall be done for you. In this My Father is esteemed, that you bear much fruit, and you shall be My taught ones. As the Father has loved Me, I have also loved you. Stay in My love. If you guard (do/obey) My commands, you shall stay in My love even as I have guarded My Father’s commands and stay in His love. These words I have spoken to you, **so that My joy might be in you, and that your joy might be complete**. John 15:7-11

“Until now you have asked naught in My Name. Ask, and you shall receive, **in order that your joy might be complete**. John 16:24

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Remember:

“Remember the word that I said to you, ‘A servant is not greater than his master.’ If they persecuted Me, they shall persecute you too. If they have guarded My Word, they would guard yours too. John 15:20

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Holy Spirit Will announce Yeshua:

“But when He comes, the Spirit of the Truth, He shall guide you into all the truth. For He shall not speak from Himself, but whatever He hears He shall speak, and He shall announce to you what is to come. John 16:13

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All Yehovah owns is Yeshua’s (including every human: Psalms 24):

“But when He comes, the Spirit of the Truth, He shall guide you into all the truth. For He shall not speak from Himself, but whatever He hears He shall speak, and He shall announce to you what is to come. He shall esteem Me, for He shall take of what is Mine and announce it to you. All that the Father has is Mine. That is why I said that He takes from what is Mine and announces it to you. John 16:13-15

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Healing:

“how Elohim (God) did anoint יהושע (Yeshua) of Natsareth (Nazareth) with the Set-apart (Holy) Spirit and with power, who went about doing good and healing all who were oppressed by the devil, for Elohim (God) was with Him.” Acts 10:38

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Handkerchief and unusual miracles:

“And Elohim (God) worked unusual miracles through the hands of Sha’ul (Saul), so that even handkerchiefs or aprons were brought from his body to the sick, and the diseases left them and the wicked spirits went out of them.” Acts 19:11-12

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Remember:

“All this I did show you, by labouring like this, that you ought to help the weak. And remember the words of the Master יהושע (Yeshua), that He said, ‘It is more blessed to give than to receive.’” Acts 20:35

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Remember:

“...do not boast against the branches. And if you boast, remember: you do not bear the root, but the root bears you!” Rom 11:18

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Yeshua gave His life for us:

“But Elohim proves His own love for us, in that while we were still sinners, Messiah died for us. Much more then, having now been declared right by His blood, we shall be saved from wrath through Him.” Romans 5:8-9

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Yeshua gave His life for us:

“For the wages of sin is death, but the favourable gift of Elohim (God) is everlasting life in Messiah יהושע (Yeshua) our Master.” Romans 6:23

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Who can be against us?

“What then shall we say to this? If Elohim (God) is for us, who is against us?” Romans 8:31

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More than overcomers:

“But in all this we are more than overcomers through Him (God) who loved us.” Romans 8:37

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Hearing the Word of God brings strong faith:

“So then belief comes by hearing, and hearing by the word of Elohim (God).” Romans 10:17

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You are the temple of the Holy Spirit:

“Do you not know that you are a Dwelling Place of Elohim (God) and that the Spirit of Elohim (God) dwells in you?” 1 Corinthians 3:16

“And you belong to Messiah, and Messiah belongs to Elohim (God).” 1 Corinthians 3:23

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Armor of God:

“Put on the complete armour of Elohim (God), for you to have power to stand against the schemes of the devil. Because we do not wrestle against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against authorities, against the world-rulers of the darkness of this age, against spiritual matters of wickedness in the heavenlies.

Because of this, take up the complete armour of Elohim, so that you have power to withstand in the wicked day, and having done all, to stand. Stand, then, having girded your waist with truth, and having put on the breastplate of righteousness, and having fitted your feet with the preparation of the Good News of peace; above all, having taken up the shield of belief with which you shall have power to quench all the burning arrows of the wicked one.

Take also the helmet of deliverance, and the sword of the Spirit, which is the Word of Elohim (God), praying at all times, with all prayer and supplication in the Spirit, watching in all perseverance and supplication for all the set-apart ones (saints);” Ephesians 6:11-18

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Prayer:

“Do not worry at all, but in every matter, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, let your requests be made known to Elohim (God).” Philippians 4:6

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Strength:

“I have strength to do all, through Messiah who empowers me.” Philippians 4:13

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Deliverance through Yeshua:

“Because Elohim (God) did not appoint us to wrath, but to obtain deliverance through our Master יהושע (Yeshua) Messiah,” 1 Thessalonians 5:9

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No Spirit Of fear:

“For Elohim (God) has not given us a spirit of cowardice, but of power and of love and of self-control.” 2 Timothy 1:7

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Remember:

“But remember the former days, when, after you were enlightened, you endured a great struggle with sufferings.” Hebrews 10:32

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Remember:

“Remember the prisoners as if chained with them, and those being mistreated, since you yourselves also are in the body.” Hebrews 13:3

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Remember:

“Remember those leading you, who spoke the Word of Elohim (God) to you. Consider the outcome of their behaviour and imitate their belief.” Hebrews 13:7

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Subject yourself to God and resist the devil:

“So then subject yourselves to Elohim (God). Resist the devil and he shall flee from you. Draw near to Elohim (God) and He shall draw near to you. Cleanse hands, sinners. And cleanse the hearts, you double-minded!” James 4:7-8

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Remember:

“...I write to you, in which I stir up your sincere mind, to remember the words previously spoken by the set-apart prophets, and of the command of the Master and Saviour, spoken by your emissaries, knowing this first: that mockers shall come in the last days with mocking, walking according to their own lusts, and saying, “Where is the promise of His coming? For since the fathers fell asleep, all continues as from the beginning of creation.” 2 Peter 3:1-4

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Answered prayers:

“And if we know that He hears us, whatever we ask, we know that we have the petitions that we have asked of Him. If anyone sees his brother sinning a sin, not unto death, he shall ask, and He shall give him life for those not sinning unto death. There is a sin unto death. I do not say that he should pray about that.” 1 John 5:15-16

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Remember:

“Remember that יהושע (Yeshua) Messiah, of the seed of Dawid (David), was raised from the dead according to my Good News,” 2 Timothy 2:8

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Remember:

“So remember from where you have fallen, and repent and do the first works, or else I shall come to you speedily and remove your lampstand from its place, unless you repent.” Revelation 2:5

Remember:

“Remember, then, how you have received, and heard. And watch and repent. If, then, you do not wake up, I shall come upon you as a thief, and you shall not know at all what hour I come upon you.” Revelation 3:3

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Unpardonable Sins:

To blaspheme and curse Yehovah. Yehovah is the Holy Spirit.

““And the Israeli woman’s son blasphemed the Name, and cursed. So they brought him to Mosheh (Moses). Now his mother’s name was Shelomith the daughter of Dibri, of the tribe of Dan. And they put him under guard, that it might be declared to them at the mouth of יהוה. And יהוה spoke to Mosheh (Moses), saying, ‘Bring the one who has cursed outside the camp, and all those who heard him shall lay their hands on his head, and all the congregation shall stone him. And speak to the children of Israel, saying, ‘Anyone who curses his Elohim shall bear his sin. And he who blasphemes the Name of יהוה (Yehovah) shall certainly be put to death, and all the congregation certainly stone him, the stranger as well as the native. When he blasphemes the Name, he is put to death.’ Lev 24:16

“**Now יהוה (Yehovah) is the Spirit**, and where the Spirit of יהוה is, there is freedom.” 2 Cor 3:17

““Because of this I say to you, all sin and blasphemy shall be forgiven men, **but the blasphemy against the Spirit shall not be forgiven men**. “And whoever speaks a word against the Son of Adam, it shall be forgiven him, **but whoever speaks against the Set-apart (Holy) Spirit, it shall not be forgiven him**, either in this age or in the age to come. Mt 12:31-32

Unpardonable Sins:

Despising Birthright Inheritance and Selling it:

“And Ya‘aqob (Jacob) cooked a stew, and Ęsaw (Esau) came in from the field, and he was weary. And Ęsaw (Esau) said to Ya‘aqob (Jacob), “Please feed me with that same red stew, for I am weary.” That is why his name was called Edom. But Ya‘aqob (Jacob) said, “Sell me your birthright today.” And Ęsaw (Esau) said, “Look, I am going to die, so why should I have birthright?” Then Ya‘aqob (Jacob) said, “Swear to me today.” And he swore to him, and sold his birthright to Ya‘aqob (Jacob). Ya‘aqob (Jacob) then gave Ęsaw (Esau) bread and stew of lentils. And he ate and drank, and rose up and left. **Thus Ęsaw (Esau) despised his birthright.**” Gen 25:29-34

“as it has been written, “Ya‘aqob (Jacob) I have loved, but Ęsaw (Esau) I have hated.” Rom 9:13, Mal 1:3

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Read for dealing with witchcraft/Magicians/idolatry, etc. (Micah 5:7-14):

7And the remnant of Ya‘aqob (Jacob) shall be in the midst of many peoples, as dew from יהוה, as showers on the grass, which do not wait for man nor delay for the sons of men.

8And the remnant of Ya‘aqob (Jacob) shall be among the nations, in the midst of many peoples, like a lion among the beasts of a forest, like a young lion among flocks of sheep, who, if he passes through, shall both tread down and shall tear, and there is no one to deliver.

9Let your hand be lifted up against your adversaries, and all your enemies be cut off.

10“And it shall be in that day,” declares יהוה (Yehovah), “that I shall cut off your horses out of your midst, and I shall destroy your chariots.

11“And I shall cut off the cities of your land, **and I shall pull down all your strongholds.**

12“**And I shall cut off witchcrafts out of your hand, and let you have no magicians.**

13“**And I shall cut off your carved images/idols, and your pillars from your midst, so that you no longer bow down to the work of your hands.**

14“**And I shall pluck your Ashērim out of your midst,** and I shall destroy your cities.

15“And I shall take vengeance in wrath and rage on the nations who did not obey.”
